

CLT testing will be held in March and April. The CLT is the Classical Learning Test that will help us assess individual students and also curriculum we use. It uses a critical thinking and logic-based approach and provides an accurate and rigorous assessment of a student's aptitude and achievement. CLT8 is a high school readiness exam given as an end-ofyear assessment. The CLT 10 is a college preparatory exam for 9th and 10th grade similar to the PSAT.
